DKV and innogy celebrate 100,000th charging point

Essen/Ratingen, 24.09.2020. Charge4Europe, the joint venture of DKV Mobility and innogy eMobility Solutions, has activated its 100,000th charging point.

Charge4Europe, which only started operations in 2019 is already celebrating a groundbreaking milestone – as it drives its way to becoming one of the largest charging networks for electric and hybrid vehicles in Europe. This impressive achievement was announced at innogy headquarters in Essen, Germany, today.

"At Charge4Europe, we are working at top speed to create a charging infrastructure that covers the whole of Europe," says Sven Mehringer, Managing Director Energy & Vehicle Services at DKV. "In this way, we want to successfully shape the energy turnaround together with our customers and partners". The joint venture currently offers access to around 30,000 charging points in Germany. Charging facility is already available in Austria, Belgium, France, the Netherlands, Luxembourg and Italy.

The expansion across countries and loading points are taking place continuously.

"Internationally, electromobility is in the fast lane. Cross-border charging is a key factor for the success of electromobility. With Charge4Europe we are targeting large vehicle fleets in particular".

By the end of this year, the Charge4Europe charging network is expected to grow to over 120,000 charging points.
